Excellent impressions and much finer than all Athens prints. The 10 lepta value with 8mm high control figures on back.





#### First Athens Coarse Print (1861-1862)

The initial printings are very coarse including a 20 lepta Provisional without numerals. Quality improved as workers' technique improved. The issues are generally classified as either coarse or fine prints.
