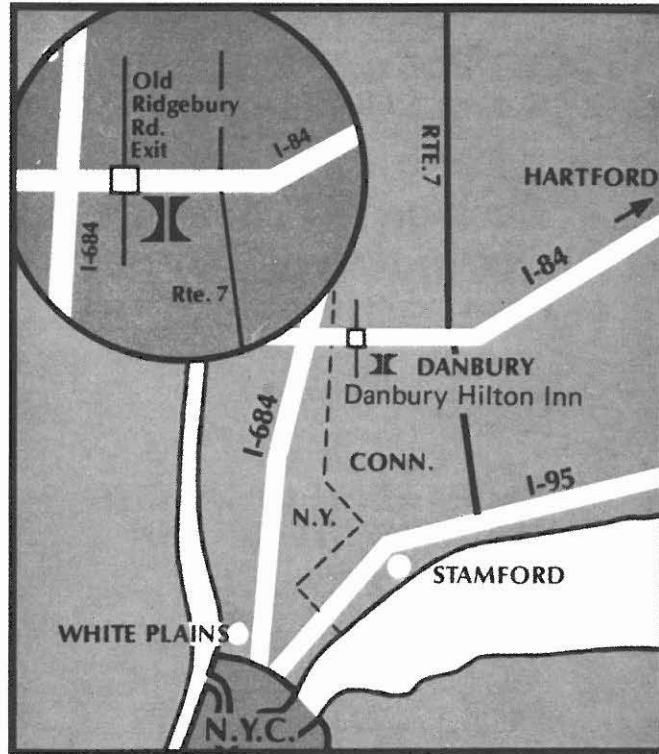

CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. Lots are sold to the highest bidder at a slight advance over the second high bid. All bids will be held confidential. "Buy" bids cannot be accepted. In case of tie, the first bid received prevails.
2. All bids are per lots as numbered in the catalogue unless otherwise announced by the auctioneer at the time of sale.
3. Any lot, the description of which is incorrect, is returnable, but only within five days of receipt. All disputed lots must be returned intact as received and lots containing five or more items are not returnable at any time. No lots may be returned by purchasers who have had the opportunity to examine them prior to the sale. We do not regard covers as defective that have slightly torn or partially missing backflap. This factor is not justification for return of a lot or lots.
4. Successful bidders, unless they are known to us or supply acceptable references in time to be properly checked are expected to make payment in full before the lots are delivered. The fact that an item is placed on extension (submitted to an expertising committee for certification) does not relieve the successful bidder from this condition of sale.
5. If the purchase price has not been paid within the time limit, nor lots taken up within seven days from date of sale they must be resold and any loss arising from such sale will be charged to the defaulter. Any account more than thirty days in arrears is subject to a late payment charge of 1½% per month so long as the account remains in arrears. If the auctioneer, in his discretion, should institute any legal action to secure payment of a delinquent account, the defaulting purchaser shall pay all legal expense incurred by the auctioneer and such charges will be added to the amount owed.
6. All lots are sold as genuine but should any lot be proved otherwise by written opinion of any competent, responsible authority acceptable to us, immediate refund of the full purchase price will be made, provided that such claim is made in writing within 14 days from date of sale. If claim is not made within this period, no lots are returnable for any reason at any time. So long as we are notified within the 14 day period that an opinion is being sought the matter will remain open until such opinion is rendered. We will not be responsible for any charges incurred by the buyer for expertization fees and costs unless the opinion states the item is not genuine, in which case we will pay actual costs up to a maximum of \$50.00. In the event an item is proved "not as described" it is returnable for full refund, and the buyer will be paid interest (at the prevailing Treasury Bill Rate) for the time his funds have been on deposit with us during the extension period.
7. The right is reserved to group two or more lots, also withdraw any lot or lots from the sale, or to act on behalf of the seller.
8. Until paid for in full all lots remain the property of Richard C. Frajola, Inc. on behalf of the seller.
9. A premium equal to 10% of the successful bid price will be added thereto and is payable by the buyer as part of the total purchase price. The mode of shipment shall be at our option. All forwarding charges will be added to the purchase price.
10. Upon written application lots may be sent for examination prior to the auction, condition upon being mailed back by registered mail, adequately insured, within 24 hours of receipt. The applicant is completely responsible for all lots sent for examination, and for the insurance of same against mishap, from the time of receipt until they are actually received back, and is to pay all expenses of postage and insurance. Condition

Condition grades mentioned in the description refer to overall appearance of the item. On covers bearing adhesives, expect normal average centering or margins for the particular issue, only when adhesive condition is above the normal will it be specifically described. File folds on folded letters that do not detract from appearance are not mentioned, nor are missing back flaps on covers if no postal markings are affected.

extremely fine—the best possible condition

very fine—pleasing appearance with all markings well struck

fine—averages appearance for period, markings readable

about fine—somewhat below average, markings partially readable

New Mexico Territory

New Mexico became a part of the United States by military occupation in 1846, and by the treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo proclaimed on July 4, 1848. Dispute continued with Texas about the eastern boundary of New Mexico until solved by the famous Compromise of 1850. The Territory of New Mexico was established thereby on December 13, 1850.

The original territorial boundaries encompassed all of what is now Arizona, part of what is now southern Nevada, and a portion of what is now southeastern Colorado. Additional territory was added as a result of continued dispute with Mexico as to the southern boundary, concluded by the Treaty of Mesilla (Gadsden Purchase) in 1853. The Colorado portion was lost with the formation of Colorado Territory on February 28, 1861. The western half was split off as the territory of Arizona on February 24, 1863.

There were ten New Mexico post offices in what is now Arizona. These were Arizona, Casa Blanca, Colorado City, Fort Buchanan, Fort Defiance, Gila City, Maricopa, Pima Village, Tubac, and Tucson. Arizona was a name change from Colorado City. (It is now Yuma.) Bringhursts, N. Mex. was a post office at the present site of Las Vegas, Nevada.

As was the case in other territories, some post offices were established in New Mexico that were never within its boundaries. Examples are Frontera and San Elizario (always in Texas). In a few cases neighboring territories had post offices established within the boundaries of New Mexico.

Special Notes

This auction catalog contains only postal history of New Mexico. The "New Mexico Territorial Postmark Catalog" by Sheldon Dike, 1981 edition, has been used to catalog the various postmark types. Every effort has been made to correctly identify the proper types but all covers are offered without guarantee as to type. Dr. Dike's light pencil notations on the covers regarding type and "earliest" or "latest" have been left on. Estimates have been based on the valuation system in the Dike catalog. As this is a collection of postmarks the quality of the postmark strike has been given primary consideration in grading.

The 1981 edition of "New Mexico Territorial Postmark Catalog" by Sheldon Dike is available for \$25.00, postage paid, from Mrs. Sheldon Dike or directly from Richard Frajola, Inc. This catalog is a "must" for all students of New Mexico Territorial postal history.

Dr. Sheldon H. Dike

As is the case with most postal historians, it was stamp collecting that gave the young boy, Sheldon Dike his start in our hobby. By the time he was a teen-ager, he had organized a small stamp business.

About 1950 some of the territorial cover collections of Dr. Carroll Chase came to market. With the help of E.N. Sampson, Dike procured not only the Arizona and New Mexico collections but also Dr. Chase's postmark tracings and records of known covers. Dr. Chase generally recorded only obviously different type postmarks. Dike extended this work to the differentiating and recording of impressions from all postmarking devices regardless of apparent similarity. These detailed data were shared in a series of catalogs both for Arizona and New Mexico. For example Dike listed 63 different postmarks from Santa Fe alone in his eighth edition of the New Mexico catalog. Such available data have greatly expanded and defined attainable collecting goals helping to generate and maintain interest.

Dike's second major contribution to postmark collecting was in developing a consistent and valid method of evaluating postmarked covers. In addition to known scarcity, age, quality and demand considerations, Dike incorporated in his formula a method of predicting the likelihood of more markings of any specific type showing up.

Dr. Dike sold his Arizona Territorial collection in 1973. This current sale offers collectors a chance to acquire some gems from the greatest New Mexico Territorial collection formed to date.

To me an "ex-Dike" cover will always carry with it the aura of uniqueness—maybe because of Doc's love for the Southwest, perhaps because of his generosity in sharing from his great reservoir of knowledge, or possibly because of his delight when even a competitor in the hobby made a "new find". Many of these covers are something special—just as Doc was! — N.L. Persson
