First National Bank of Pueblo

The First National Bank of Pueblo was organized on June 5, 1871. It was granted charter #1833. The bank remained active well beyond the Territorial period.

First National Bank of Central City

The First National Bank of Central City was organized on September 15, 1873. It was granted charter #2129. The bank was forced into receivership on October 9, 1933.

Colorado National Bank of Denver

The Colorado National Bank of Denver was organized in August 1866 as successor to the private banking firm of Kountze Brothers. It was granted charter #1651. The bank remained active well beyond the Territorial period.

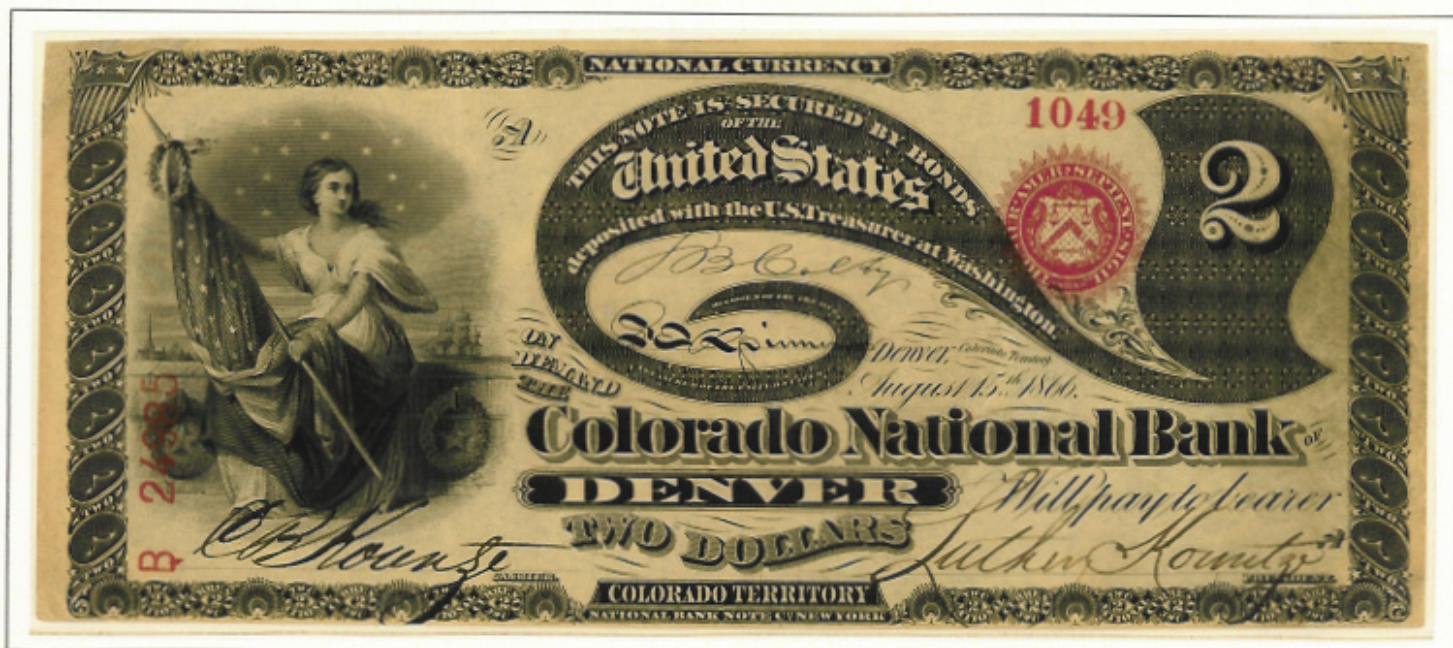

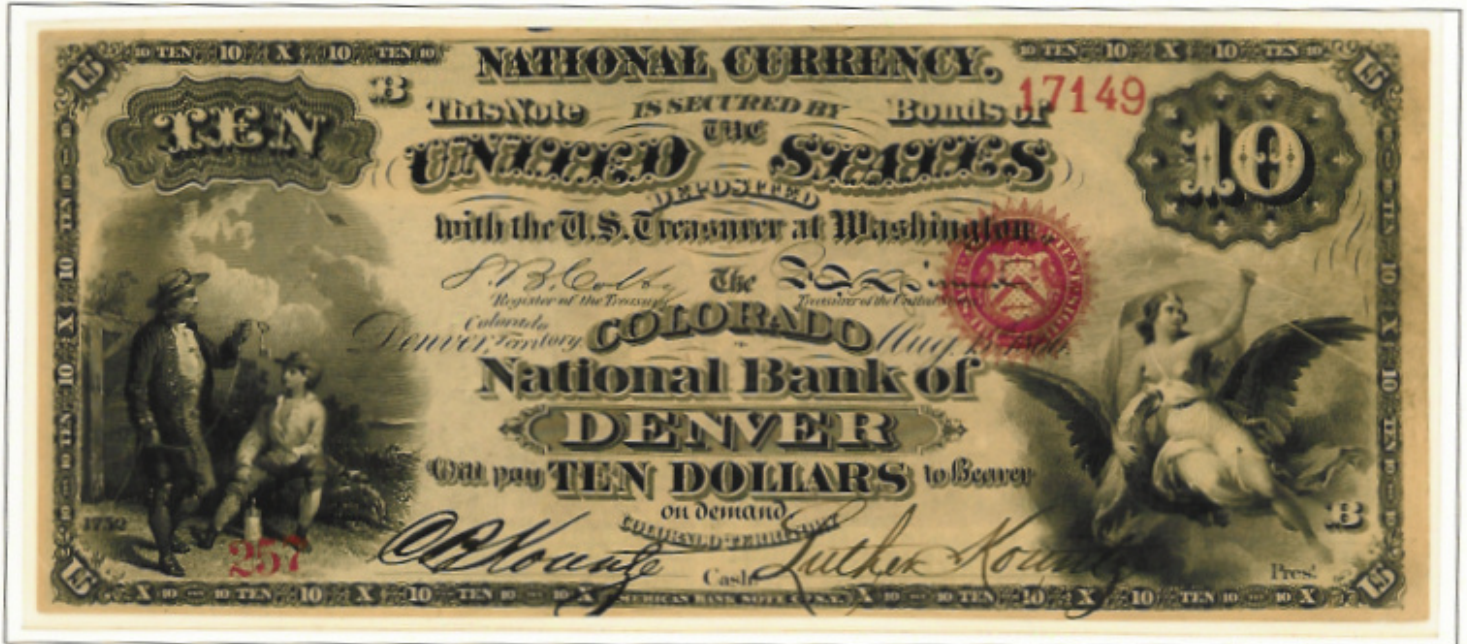

\$10 National Currency issue of August 15, 1866

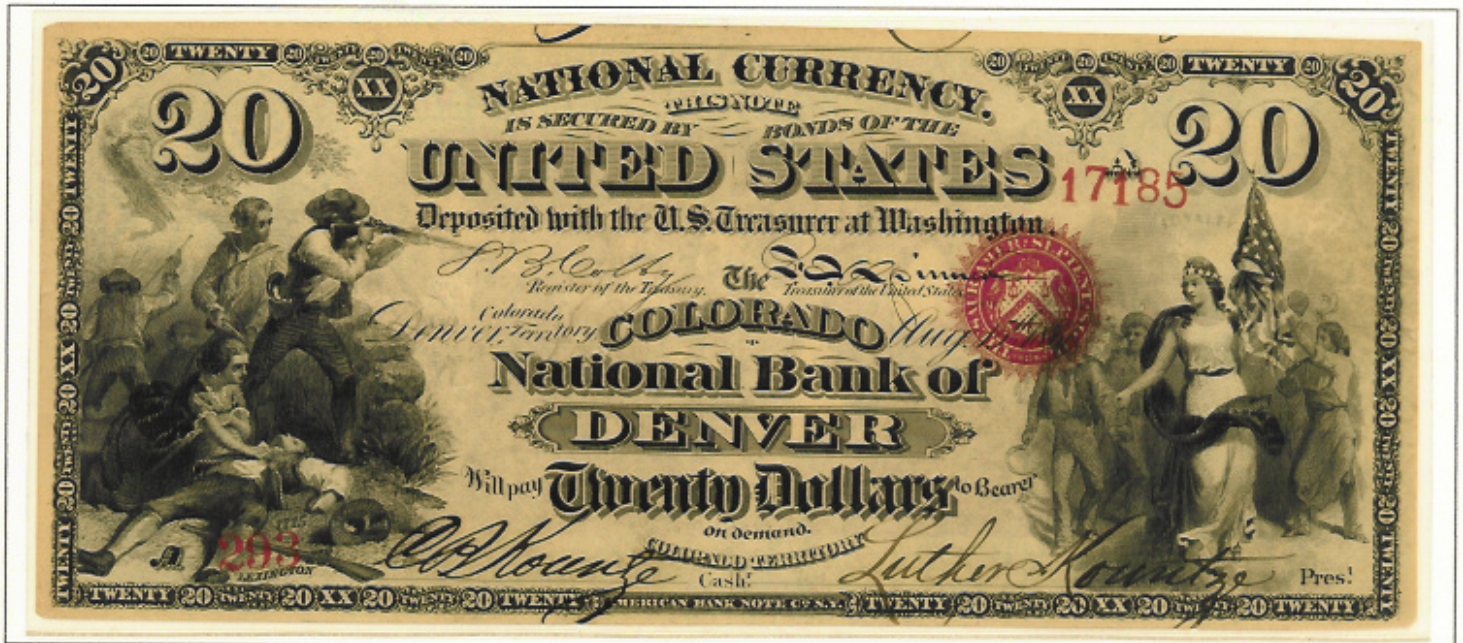
