ACT OF MARCH 25, 1851
FROM AND AFTER APRIL 6, 1851

THE AGREEMENT PROVIDED FOR UNITED STATES POSTAGE AT FIVE CENTS FOR DISTANCES LESS THAN 3000 MILES AND TEN CENTS IF GREATER. THE CANADIAN POSTAGE WAS SET AT FIVE CENTS. THUS THE COMBINED RATE WAS TEN CENTS OR FIFTEEN CENTS. THE POSTAGE COULD BE PREPAID OR COLLECT, BUT PART PAYMENT WAS NOT ALLOWED.

THE NORWICH BANK DEPOSITED THIS LETTER IN THE NORWICH POST OFFICE WITH A THREE CENT STAMP. ENCLOSED WITH THE LETTER, WAS A BANK DRAFT PLUS \$12.50 IN BILLS. THE WEIGHT EXCEEDED 1/2 OZ., SO AN ADDITIONAL THREE CENTS WAS REQUIRED IF PAID IN ADVANCE, BUT THE LETTER LEFT NORWICH BEFORE THIS WAS DONE, SO 5 CENTS WAS DUE WHEN THE LETTER WAS PICKED UP AT PROVIDENCE.

HOWEVER IT GOT LOST IN THE POSTAL SYSTEM FOR ALMOST SIX YEARS. BY THE TIME IT ARRIVED IN NORWICH ON JANUARY 11, 1968 THE POST CARD RATE HAD INCREASED TO FIVE CENTS. NOTICING THAT THE POST CARD DID NOT HAVE SUFFICIENT POSTAGE THE NORWICH POST OFFICE AFFIXED TWO 1 CENT POSTAGE DUE STAMPS. THIS TWO CENTS WAS COLLECTED FROM THE NORWICH HOUSING AUTHORITY.
