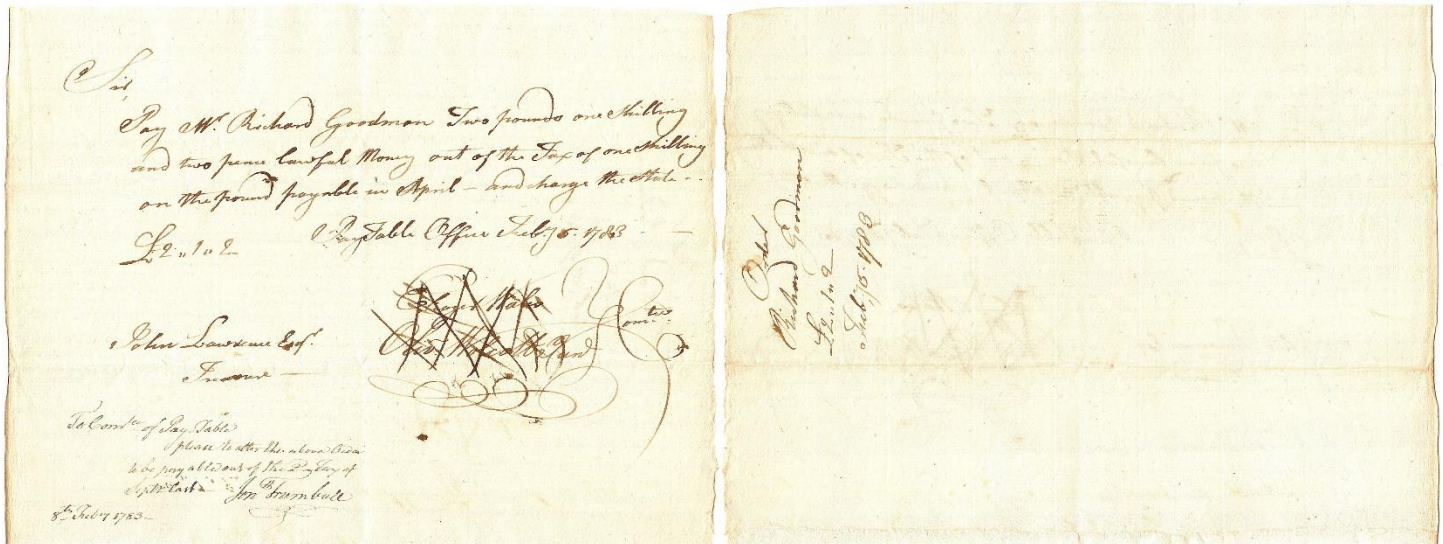

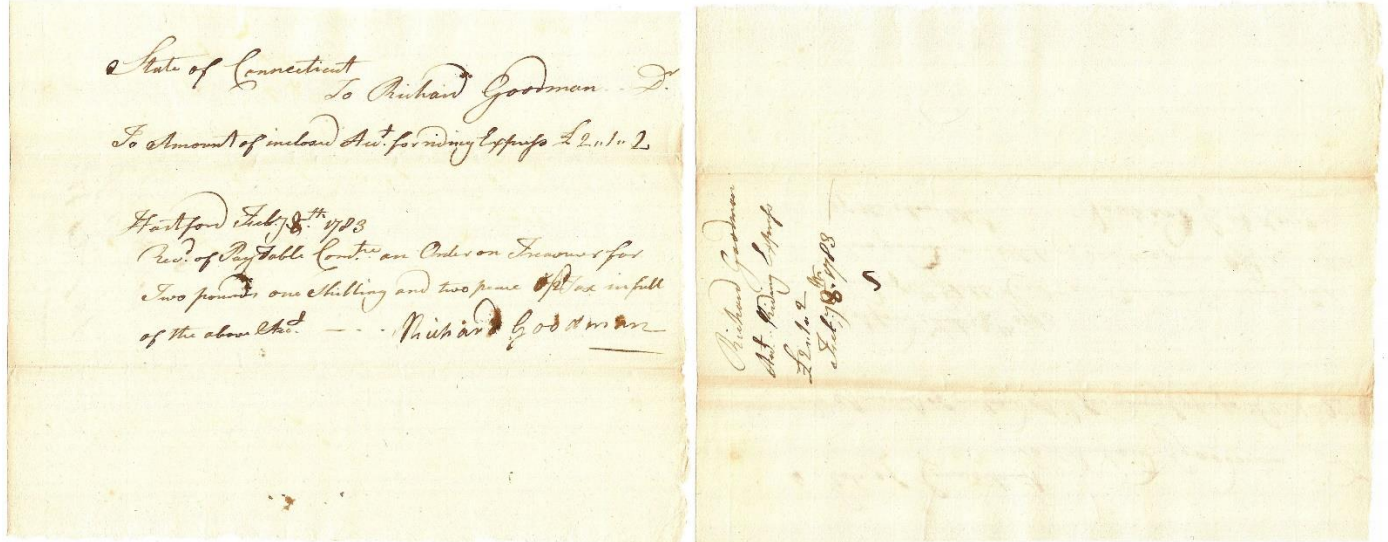

1783 February 8: Pay Table Order



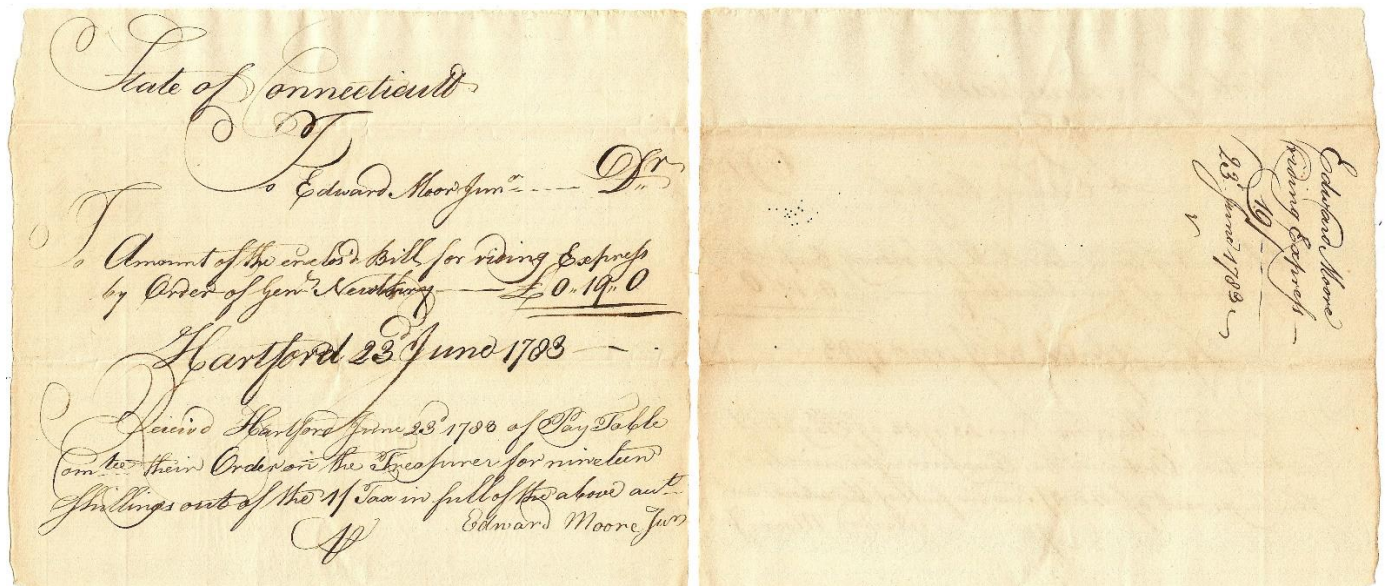
