The Public Records of the State of Connecticut

This event occurs September 19 1777 after the above document, but shows that Thomas was free while Franklin was on parole.

Whereas his Excellency William Livingston, Esq^r, Governor of the State of New Jersies, by his letter of the 19th of September, representing that Mr. Franklin, late Governor of New Jersey, having possessed himself of a chest or box containing Minutes of Council, Examinations in Council and other papers of consequence to that State, thought proper, as there is great reason to believe, a few days before he was apprehended to secrete them, which papers they have not been able upon the most diligent search to recover; desiring that this State would interpose and cause the said Mr. Franklin and his man Thomas, who is suspected to be privy to the concealment, to be examined on oath relative to said matter, and requesting that said Thomas might be first examined before he has opportunity to consult with his said master upon the subject.

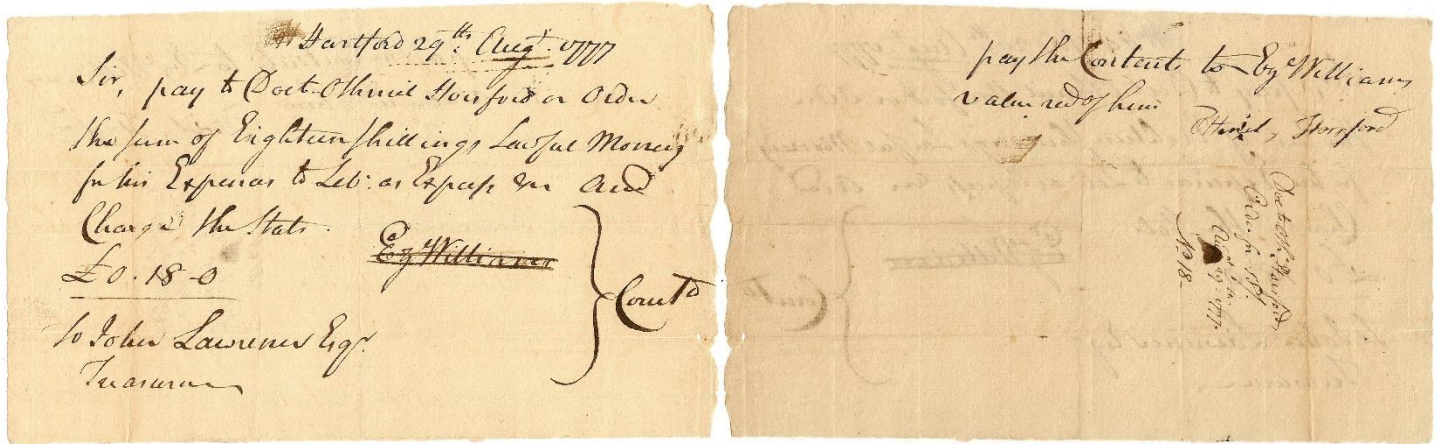

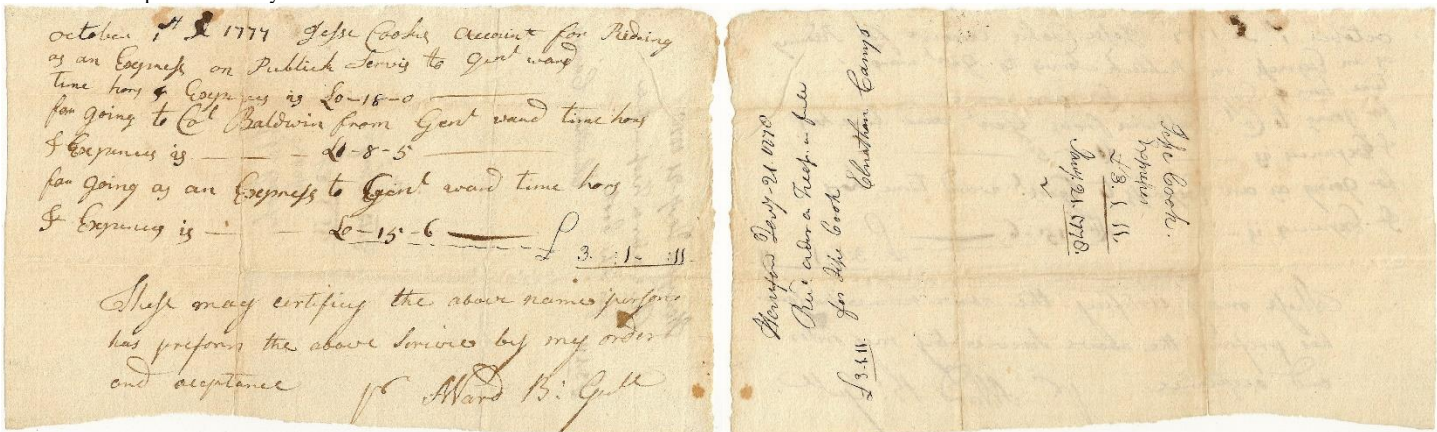
