The early postmaster-printer-patriots of New Haven played significant roles during the Revolutionary War and in the establishment of the Boston Post Road.

New Haven.....Parker, James 1754 British Colonial Post

Appointed postmaster of New Haven by Benjamin Franklin in 1754, James Parker established the first printing press in New Haven, which he bought directly from Franklin. Parker was active in printing and journalism in New York and New Jersey; he also became printer to Yale College in New Haven. His first work was the printing of the laws of the college, in Latin, probably in December, 1754. Just one year later, on April 12, 1755, Parker founded *The Connecticut Gazette*, the first paper in the colony. John Holt served as editor and junior partner; Thomas Green assisted. The first number bore the imprint, "Printed by James Parker at the Post-Office near the Sign of the White Horse."

John Holt was the former mayor of Williamsburgh, VA, his birthplace. He left New Haven by July, 1760, to take charge of Parker's printing house in New York.

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Parker & Company (Holt bought out Parker in 1762) discontinued the printing business in New Haven in 1764. Isaiah Thomas says "they resigned the business to Benjamin Mecom."

Thomas Green moved to Hartford in the autumn of 1764. He and his brother, Samuel, launched the *Connecticut Courant* newspaper on October 29th of that year. It is the oldest continuously published paper in the US today.

The Greens did not stay long in Hartford and returned to New Haven. In 1767 they founded another very successful newspaper, *The Connecticut Journal-Courier*, in New Haven.

Mecom, Benjamin		1764		
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Appointed Postmaster of New Haven by his uncle, Benjamin Franklin.

Mecom, the son of his uncle Benjamin Franklin's favorite sister Jane, was known to his family as 'Benny'. However, because of his eccentric affectations and erratic behavior, Bostonians nicknamed him "Queer Notions" after the title of one of his own newspaper columns of the 1750s.

In 1764 *The Connecticut Gazette* suspended publication, but was afterwards revived by Benjamin Mecom on July 5, 1765.

Mecom went out of business in February 1768, closing with an announcement asking anybody who owed him money to pay up so that he and his family could afford to move out of town. The peripatetic printer sold out to Samuel Green and moved to Philadelphia.

While in Philadelphia Mecom was employed by William Goddard, printer and "Father of the US Postal System," until 1774.
