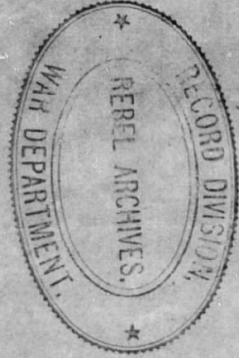

January 27<sup>th</sup> 1865

Sir:  
I have the honor very respectfully to apply for my Commission as Colonel of the 9<sup>th</sup> Regiment of Kentucky Cavalry to date from December 17<sup>th</sup> 1862. to which rank I am entitled, as will be seen by reference to the records in your office. I forwarded muster rolls of my Regiment in January 1863 thro the office of Gen John H. Morgan, to whose Command I was then attached - with full statement of its organization & request for Commission. These papers were lost in the transmission of which fact I was not informed until January 1864 when I made verbal application to the proper officer in the War Department. Again in March 1864 I forwarded full statement of the organization of the Regiment. The extreme activities of the Command to which I belong for the past ten months has prevented my pressing this application. I have since December 17<sup>th</sup> 1862 been in constant command of my Regiment except when I have commanded the brigades of which at different times it has formed a part.


