## CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. Lots are sold to the highest bidder at a slight advance over the second high bid. All bids will be held confidential. "Buy" bids cannot be accepted. In case of tie, the first bid received prevails.
2. All bids are per lots as numbered in the catalogue unless otherwise announced by the auctioneer at the time of sale.
3. Any lot, the description of which is incorrect, is returnable, but only within five days of receipt. All disputed lots must be returned intact as received and lots containing five or more items are not returnable at any time. No lots may be returned by purchasers who have had the opportunity to examine them prior to the sale. We do not regard covers as defective that have slightly torn or partially missing backflap. This factor is not justification for return of a lot or lots.
4. Successful bidders, unless they are known to us or supply acceptable references in time to be properly checked are expected to make payment in full before the lots are delivered. The fact that an item is placed on extension (submitted to an expertising committee for certification) does not relieve the successful bidder from this condition of sale.
5. If the purchase price has not been paid within the time limit, nor lots taken up within seven days from date of sale they must be resold and any loss arising from such sale will be charged to the defaulter. Any account more than thirty days in arrears is subject to a late payment charge of $11 / 2 \%$ per month so long as the account remains in arrears. If the auctioneer, in his discretion, should institute any legal action to secure payment of a delinquent account, the defaulting purchaser shall pay all legal expense incurred by the auctioneer and such charges will be added to the amount owed.

## Condition

Condition grades mentioned in the description refer to overall appearance of the item. On covers bearing adhesives, expect normal average centering or margins for the particular issue, only when adhesive condition is above the normal will it be specifically described. File folds on folded letters that do not detract from appearance are not mentioned, nor are missing back flaps on covers if no postal markings are affected.

## INTRODUCTION

It is our great pleasure to offer the collection of 1861 issue postage stamps and postal history formed by William K. Herzog. A noted student of this fascinating issue and associate editor of the 1861-1869 period for The Chronicle Mr. Herzog has effectively combined the two great branches of philately, postage stamps and postal history.

The collection of postage stamps formed by Mr. Herzog reflects his eye for the subtle differences of shade so prevalent with the issue. Not content with simply finding the best possible example of each shade Mr. Herzog has quite successfully attempted to define periods of usage for each shade with covers and establish a chronology of shades. By this documentation he has increased our knowledge of which shades most likely represent separate and distinguishable printings. Mr. R. White in his Encyclopedia Of The Colors Of United States Postage Stamps used numerous Herzog examples to illustrate scarce shades.

The collection of postal history, in addition to establishing shade usages, shows evidence of Mr. Herzog's interest in all aspects of mail handling during the period. Exceptional routings, rates and destinations abound in his foreign usages but unusual domestic usages were not ignored. Auxilliary markings, combination frankings as well as scarcer classes of mail service can be found.

Mr. Herzog has been a frequent exhibitor and has received a gold award in international competition (Interphil 1976) as well as five grand awards in national competition on with his collections. His numerous articles are well known and several of the items offered in this auction have been treated therein.
